**OUR MISSION for the Bonham Pregnancy Care Center ...**

The Mission for the Fannin Pregnancy Care Center (FPCC) in Bonham is to empower women and men with information to make informed and confident decisions about unexpected pregnancies, sexually transmitted diseases (infections), and to provide sexual and relational health education in Fannin County and surrounding areas.

**THE NEED for the Fannin Pregnancy Care Center ...**

The need for the Fannin Pregnancy Care Center in Bonham continues to increase as the number of our youth having sexual relations continues to rise. Abortion is a major issue facing the girls and women of every community, even rural. The number of pregnancies also continues to rise - not only due to unprotected sex but because of the need for sexual and relational health education. Many girls and women struggling to make a decision will not drive to the Pregnancy Care Center in Sherman or Paris for counsel, but will make the trip to Dallas for a pregnancy termination. The convenient location of FPCC offers the girls and women of Fannin County and surrounding communities the opportunity to know all their options and make a choice based upon truth and knowledge. FPCC staff and volunteers clearly explain every option. With the support of our local community, FPCC offers help and hope for struggling, pregnant women and their families.



**Project Goals for FPCC ...**

The goal for the Fannin Pregnancy Care Center is to provide women and girls in unplanned pregnancies information and resources about all their options at no cost to them. FPCC assists our clients by providing a non-threatening, non-judgmental place for them to consider all their options: parenting, adoption referrals, and pregnancy termination information. The FPCC does not refer or perform abortions of any kind. The services of the FPCC include pregnancy testing, individual support and encouragement, sonograms to determine gestational age, factual abortion information, parenting classes, childbirth classes, material goods services, adoption referrals, and health/human services referrals.

FPCC depends on the monthly support of churches, businesses, individuals, and grants. FPCC has two major fund-raisers throughout the year: a dinner, and a baby bottle campaign. Our 3rd Annual fund-raising dinner is planned for October.

Starting in September, the FPCC will be adding an additional evening of service to accommodate clients who are attending school or are employed.

Join us for a great nite of food, fun, great networking, and get acquainted with the services of Fannin Pregnancy Center. Festivities will be from 5:30 to 7:30 pm at 1500 North Center Street, next to Family Video.

# INQUIRY REPORT

During the month of August the Bonham Area Chamber of Commerce has professionally handled 588 Inquiry Calls, 137 Administrative Calls, and 293 Walk-ins. We sent out 13 Tourism Packets, 15 Relocation Packets, and 0 Demographics. We also handled 105 calls about Special Events. The total number of referrals from the Chamber's website business directory this period was 1,896 and each day there was an average of 53 referrals from the Chamber's Website directory.

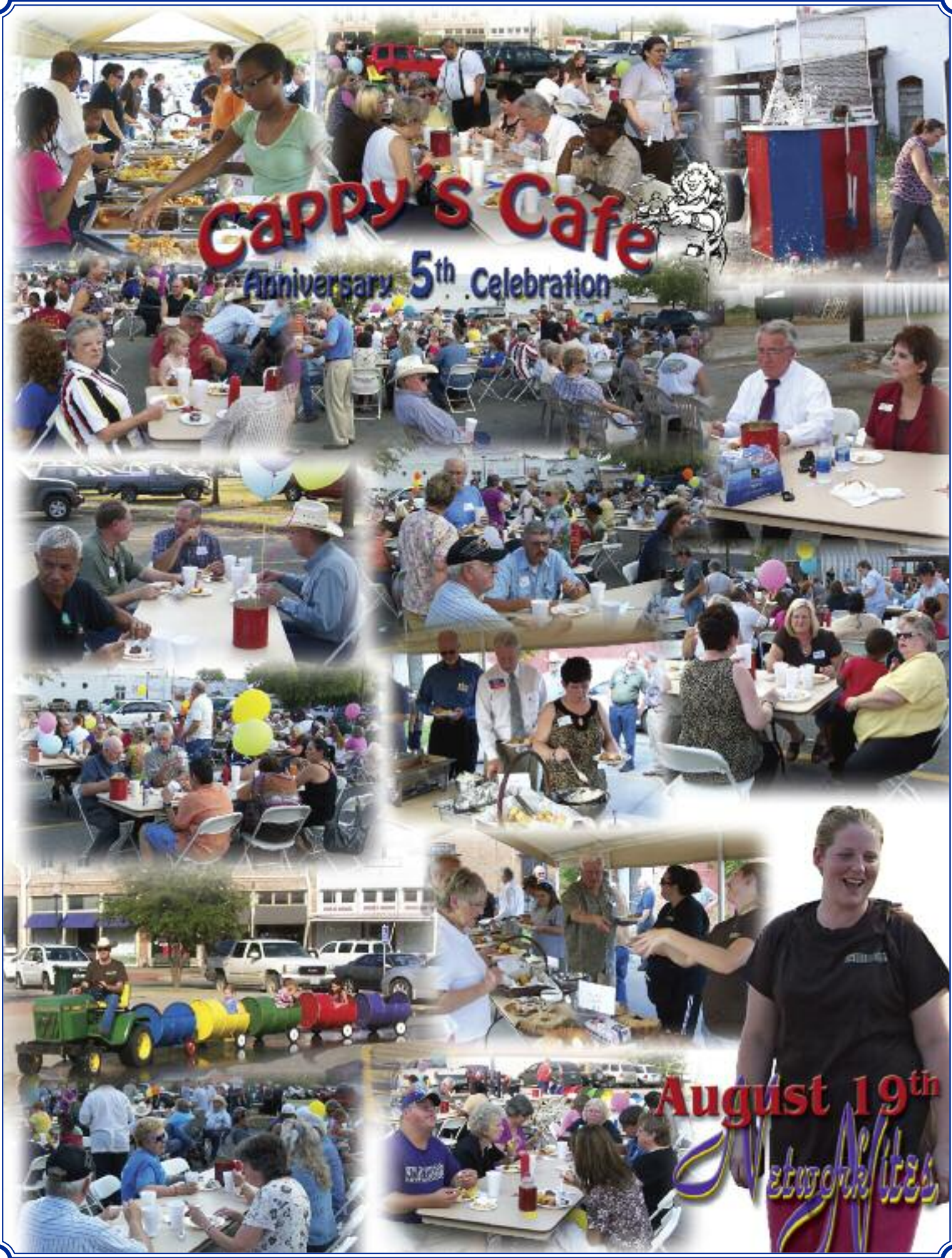

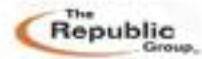
